All of these courses are credit-bearing and the final course grade goes toward the GPA. Therefore, students are expected to abide by the following guidelines:

Class meets daily from 7:20 until 8:10 a.m.

- Doors open at 7:15 a.m.
- Doors will remain open until 7:20 a.m.

Tardies will be recorded for students who arrive after 7:20 a.m.

- First and second tardies are recorded with no further action taken.
- Third tardy and subsequent tardies will result in a referral submitted to the administration.
- Three tardies equals one unexcused absence.

Absences will be recorded.

- Absences will only be excused if upon return a written excuse is submitted to the zero period teacher.
- Students who are absent from Zero Period but attend the rest of the school day will receive one unexcused absence until an excuse, that is approved by the administration, has been submitted.
- Students are allowed 5 unexcused absences **per year**. On the 6th unexcused absence or an additional tardy, students will be dropped from the course. So once a student has reached 5 unexcused absences, ANY attendance issue will result in being dropped from the class.

If you agree to the policies of the Zero Period Course, sign and return this form by Monday, August 12th.

If you do not wish to remain in the Zero Period Course, let your teacher know and the course will be dropped from your schedule.
